





Just like today.


The persistance of eternity Skadar lake

Skadar lake


Now, come up high and gaze at these waters, leaving behind all that you seek. Surrender to the impression and do nothing else but observe the scene.


The stone Jankovića krš

A solid perspective. Safeness.





As a temple of peace and harmony among the brotherhood, the church of Saint Nikola was built here in the 18th century. Its history lies on something more distant in time - the current church was raised from the ground in the place where the remains of an ancient Christian place of worship were found, and it testifies to the deep spirituality of the people who created life here centuries ago.

Within its modest courtyard, which exudes the silence, and gentleness of generations, contained are the eternal houses of many Janković family ancestors - the same ones who once here tamed stone, grapes, and juniper. They fought the hand of the enemy and the hand of nature, tenacious in their intention to survive. Holding tight to their own identity as a sense of pride.

Entering the church, a sense of the micro-universe is experienced, condensed, but with a window as a symbol of opening to everything that comes.

The embrace of generations, time, and habits indicates the continuous birth and changing of the images that slip away from the individual's perspective. Pictures that narrate only one thing.

Life was happening. Life happens. And life will happen here as long as describing it with a time limit will be possible.

What defines the relationship between man and nature, and what remains in the time that has passed and that is yet to come, is the trace. The way in which the human hand made its impact on the resources.


Come and experience history.

The Church of St. Nicholas is a beacon of life in this place. A desperate need. Joy and satisfaction all at once. For centuries, it has been a symbol of the well-fed spirit of local people.





From the perspective of tradition

The old house / Jankovića krš

In everything that is permanent and that defies time lies the spark of something that rests on strong roots. Four walls close the space with their edges and define one's past existence. They give contours to something that was here a long time ago but will remain here forever.

The house you see was built by the hands of a true hero, Mišo Šunjin Janković, a flag bearer of the Montenegrin Guard and a participant in the great battle at Vučji do. Under this flag, he was wounded and lost his life, while proudly standing still for his country.

With his courage and heroism, he illuminated a passage - from the past, through the present, and towards the future. So much so that this stone house, where he used to live with his mother, actually grew into a lighthouse of a specific time.

A symbol above symbols, which today points to the glorious history of the Jank-ović brotherhood, who settled here at the beginning of the 18th century and with a firm hand founded- and then maintained- the culture of the entire place. Taking on agriculture and dedicating themselves mainly to wine growing.

It is exactly that subtle penetration of the sun's rays through juniper and stone that was enough to create something as refined as wine.

A wine that gives an extra touch to the shades of white and green that reign in this area. Making it even warmer.


Towards the future



Choosing to stay in such an area characterizes an individual who purposefully achieves his own slow living: he came here in order to distance himself from the dynamism implied by modern ways of living, and accepted to fit into a unique system in which the emphasis is exclusively on nature and its flows - guided by it, he accepts to become part of the community he will explore and contribute to.







Mindful steps Activities / content

The concept of slow living is contained in all the segments of existence in this area: from a visit to the Skadar Lake, which has over 280 species of birds, and represents an important resting place and feeding ground for numerous migratory species (thus ideal for birdwatching), while, on the other hand, it is the center of the spiritual life of historical Montenegro because, in its composition and in its vicinity, it contains numerous monasteries, through Rijeka Crnojevića, whose history greatly enriches the location, to the untouched nature of the Jankovića krš area. As a part of staying in a special ecosystem, it offers multiple activities and inspires the individual to surrender to absolute unity with the environment. At the same time, this unit stands out as a desirable and sufficient dimension in which one of the key benefits for an individual is the connection with himself.

In this regard, we will present the described contents by units, where each of them represents a component of comprehensive satisfaction. A part of the final impression that an individual takes from this specific life station.








I exist and I see existence

Skadar lake

Welcome to the area of the largest lake in the Balkans. In this region, the benefit of an element of crucial importance for humans, such as water, is a fantastic introduction to exploring this territory. When staying in this nature reserve that is extremely rich in silence (and that will feed the souls of visitors regardless of the choice of activity), it is all matter of your preference. Therefore, you shall feel free and choose between boat tours, visiting monasteries and fortifications, or opting for swimming, kayaking, hiking, or taking one of the car safari tours.

Coexistence with the animal world is characterized by ornithological stations, five of them - Manastirska tapija, Grmožur, Omerova gorica, Crni žar, and Pančevo oko, where the special feature is represented by the possibility of observing the curly pelican and the second largest cormorant colony in Europe. Bird watching, apart from the mentioned stations and viewpoints, is also organized from smaller boats that permit better access and closer contact with the living moment - this way you'll be able to immerse yourself in every sound, every gentle wave, and every ray of sunlight caught on the lake.

Also, related to the starting point of the story, in which it was pointed out how the lake fed the entire area throughout history, it is important to point out fishing (possible by obtaining a license) as one of the main components of staying at the lake - in the Skadar lake basin, there are as many as 33 domestic and 15 introduced species - a total of 48 of them in one European lake is something that a certain water surface can rarely boast of.



The center of the spiritual life Skadar lake

This notch in the eternity, shaped into a water surface in the middle of stonerich Montenegro, can also become your charming passage to the spiritual stations that built the identity of an entire nation and with that enriched its culture, history, and tradition. Available for you to explore and help you soothe, find, or rebuild yourself.

Monasteries within and in the immediate vicinity of Lake Skadar, the oldest of which dates back to the 11th century, are Prečista Krajinska (only the foundation has been preserved to this day), then Starčevo, Kom, Beška, Orahovo, Donji Brčeli, Sveti Nikola, Gornji Brčeli, Jeksha, and Moračnik.

In order: Prečista Krajinska or Ostros monastery is located on the southwestern shore of Lake Skadar, near the villages of Mali and Veliki Ostros. Today, most of it lays in ruins, of which the tower or belfry on the western part is the one best preserved. Some visible remains of the extensive walls of the complex have been preserved only (again - in part) on the northern side.

The Starčevo Monastery is located in the southeastern part of the island that carries the same name, and very much like the island, it is named after its founder, the elder Makarios, a hesychast and prominent spiritual leader of his time. The monastery was a well-known copying center in the Middle Ages, and today only three manuscripts are surely known and recognized as created in the scriptorium at Starčevo: the Prologue (from the seventies of the 14th century), the Four Gospels of Starčevo Gorica and the third, a destroyed manuscript about the death of Đurað Balšić.

Also known as the king of the lake, the Kom monastery is located in the north-western part of Lake Skadar, near Žabljak Crnojevića, on the slope of Adrijska gora, which turns into an island during the flood period, while during the very dry summer, the monastery can be reached by following the small roads through the swamp. The Kom monastery with a church dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin, an endowment of Đurđe and Lješ Crnojević, was built between 1415 and 1427. In one specific period, this monastery was the seat of the Metropolitanate of Zeta.

The Beška Monastery is located on the island that holds its name, in a place called Donji Murići, and it is decorated with two important endowment medieval churches - one is the endowment of Đurađ II Stracimirović Balšić, lord of the Zeta and coastal lands, and is dedicated to Saint George. The second one, dedicated to the Annunciation, is the endowment of Jelena Lazareva Balšić, the daughter of the Holy Prince Lazar and Đurađ's wife, otherwise the ruler of Zeta after her husband's death.

The Orahovo Orthodox monastery is located in the village Orahovo, about two kilometers away from Virpazar.

There are no preserved written sources about the origin of the monastery. It is not even known when it lost its function as a monastery and when exactly its church became a cemetery temple. The monastery complex consists of two churches and an inn. The construction of the older, smaller single-nave church dates back to the 15th century, i.e. during the time of Jelena Balšić, when the

Orahovo monastery was mentioned as the metoh of the Vranjina monastery, while the younger monastery church, St. Nikola, was most likely built in the middle of the 17th century.

In the Crmnica villages of Donji and Gornji Brčeli, two monasteries are carrying the same name as the mentioned villages. The Monastery of St. Nikola in Donji Brčeli is older, and its foundation dates back to the beginning of the 15th century and is attributed to Jelena Balšić, while the one in Gornji Brčeli was built by Bishop Danilo Petrović at the beginning of the 18th century as his winter residence (though its foundation is also linked to Jelena Balšić). It is popularly known as the Petrović Monastery. The church is dedicated to the Feast of the Intercession of the Virgin - this rare iconographic theme illustrating the event of the appearance of the Virgin to the believers in the Constantinople church in the 10th century.

The Monastery of Saint Nikola is located on the eastern slope of Vranjina, once the largest island on Lake Skadar. This monastery was built between 1221 and 1233, during the time of Nemanjići and the first Zeta bishop Hilarion. After the arrival of the Turks in these areas, the monastery was burned and destroyed several times, until around 1842 when it was completely demolished, and a Turkish fortress was built on its foundations.

After regaining control over the island, Prince Nikola rebuilt the monastery in 1886 as a single-nave structure.

Outdoor activities

If the choice consists of other outdoor activities, the specificity of the trails around the lake (suitable for touring with the availability of local guides), then the water chestnut (as they call it here)-decorated view of thousands of water lilies while kayaking on the lake are special sparks of the experience of this area. Contained in the richness of biodiversity, these sparks form a fantastic basis for discovering a new universe and the first profound step towards merging with the local community.

Only when you walk on it will you be able to enter the deepest secret of a path you have taken. Of a path that leads you to your goal. Only while sailing the water of your path will you feel safeness and belonging. Only by being there, with that unsurpassed first-person perspective on contact between worlds, will you be convinced that your place is right there. That it is just that important and just that big.

In this interweaving of land and water on one hand and history and culture on the other, there is only one message that is sublimated: come.

Within the river of Time

Rijeka Crnojevića

Rijeka Crnojevića represents some kind of capital of smaller urban units - even though it is inhabited, with its unusualness and history of life along the river, it has preserved the authentic spirit and charm of a small town that, in its essence, carries the inseparability with nature.

Here, the local spirit manifested itself through an emphasis on gastronomic specialties, so much so that the whole locality is recognized for organizing fish and wine dinners, events that allow the local population to proudly share their products with the curious.

On this occasion, they are ready to provide advice in the field of viticulture and the specific way of preparing caught fish- and this is undoubtedly a special kind of decoration of anyone's experience. Apart from gastronomy, history also had something important to say here - this now fishing village can boast of the oldest preserved building, an example of architecture as it once was - the house of Saint Peter of Cetinje. The construction of the nominated house started in 1810, for the residential needs of St. Peter.

In the past, the building even served as an industry, when the Montenegrin-Austrian society founded a sawmill in it, back in 1873.

Old bridges, symbols of the meeting of worlds and the shades of those worlds, and the promenade along the river which so authentically revives the moments of the bright history of Rijeka, point to that intersection today. Moments in which what today seems drowned in oblivion and hidden from the life that noisily happens elsewhere, are returned on merit and show Rijeka with what it has won its proud existence and resisted time. The Venice of Montenegro.

If water gave life to everything you see here, then surely it was the stone who settled and sustained it. The same one in which the existing houses were built, as well as the one in which the new ones will be built. Today, this richness of views made up of countless interwoven shades is actually a solid refuge in a subset of stone and juniper, which finds the basis of its existence, and since then forever practices- openness. Towards peace. Towards silence. To the vastness.

Life in coexistence. Here we build existence in the embrace. Traditional and modern, which met in the idea of sustainability.

And that is exactly the idea that surrounds each of the actions on the site of importance: sustainability. When building future units, breathing freedom will be the concept we strive to donate to the existing in a location of significance. The series of activities that the individual will act through the community in the newly created space can be summarized by the definition: leave a mark. Give and take.

That giving will primarily refer to the contribution to the aforementioned idea of sustainability. Investing peace into peace.





Sustain. Revive Activities on the site

The search for authenticity in a resort that is based on a beautiful fusion with nature implies a stay in a green system, where most of the experience is contained in getting to know local ways and promoting those ways.




Juniper Jankovića krš

Juniper grows everywhere in this place. By creating a certain layer of security and more hidden reality, it makes the stone not seem lonely, while at the same time making sure that it does not seem cruel to the one who approaches it for the first time. It is a kind of initial hug to those who go to meet it.

Content emerges from that embrace. Further action is born. Juniper, on the other hand, is the main ingredient used to make gin. In this regard, this plant, a permanent resident of Jankovića krš, finds an additional way to enter your everyday life. It is in fact a resident imbued with tradition decorated with notes of modernity.

The production of gin in loco will be organized here, and that production will round off an entire process - picking, preparing, cleaning, and cooking. Melting it into reality. All this with your help and contribution. Remember the trail. Because the trail is reflected in the participation. In the creation of the experience. Just by taking part in such a unique process and at a specific venue, you have made a lasting contribution.





A stay in eco village Jankovića krš

Staying in an eco-village is an ideal way to exist here in the cross-section of the worlds- the traditional one, reflected in the ways in which people have lived here since the first day, and the one that comes and develops in order to meet the modern age. All of that while keeping everything that makes it unique.

When trying to get to know the identity of a place, and therefore people, the first thing that is presented to you is habits. By getting to know the habits of the people to whom the Jankovića krš has been their home since birth, you will be able to sharpen your perspective and, in a way, see the entire picture.

In order for your experience to be crowned with the imprint you leave here, you will be integrated through each of the sequences of the mentioned habits - learning how to produce basic foods, such as cheese and milk, participating in traditional ways of preparing food, working on the farm, with an aim to create and maintain a sustainable community, etc.

You give yourself and borrow for yourself.

In the new structures, created in such a way that in every element they imitate the existing ones (therefore, they fit into the unity of traditional materials - stone, land, and water), the stay itself will mean a peaceful existence in the area. Slow living here is achieved by the cyclical action of the individual in a given space, in relation to the contribution to the community through the renewal of habits on a daily basis. All so that nature, acting in its usual course and remaining untouched, would eventually repay that same individual by forming a gentle relationship. In a few words, what is both necessary and sufficient is the contribution to maintaining the natural balance.

Give back to yourself



In order for the place to share healthy habits and present the concept of sustainability as the healthiest of ideas that will bind us nicely and securely to the future, various thematic workshops will be organized. On this occasion, each of the mentioned actions that signify the identity of this place will be discussed and practiced on the spot - cheese production in a traditional way, preparation of traditional local specialties, use of juniper in the production of gin, etc.

In addition to daily habits, the connection with tradition is also reflected in the understanding of the way in which local people observe the phenomenon of life. More precisely, in order for this station of the individual visitor's life to be completely authentic, it is desirable to borrow a local experience of higher dimensions.

The previously presented church of St. Nikola in the village of Jankovića krš is an inseparable part of their life cycle. A center of tranquility in a place of tranquility. Participating in regular annual rituals that are related to this religious object represents exactly that additional dimension through which it is desirable to live in this place. A rough example - you are integrated into the tangible and the intangible. But - in everything that this locality is.

What can represent some special kind of authenticity is organizing a wedding in this specific location. In a place where the stone is so dominant, yet flexible enough not to harm the harmony, the wedding will definitely be a unique ceremony. A unique sum. Memories, experiences, hopes, special wishes. It is precisely this sum that is so reflected in this landscape that seems to be made of dreams. But still realistic and sensitive to the touch.

REGION I

Region I includes cadastral plots no. 4810/1, 4811 and 4812 CM Meterizi that are within the boundaries of the Spatial Urban Plan of the Old Royal Capital of Cetinje. According to the land use plan from the referred spatial planning document:

- Cadastral plot no 4811 CM Meterizi is located within the scope of other natural areas
- Cadastral plot no. 4812 CM Meterizi is located within the scope of agricultural areas
- Cadastral plot no. 4810/1 CM Meterizi is partially within the scope of other natural areas, partially within the scope of forest areas, and smaller part is within the scope of agricultural areas.

In accordance with these guidelines, Region I, with a total area of 58,813m², is divided into 4 zones with uses according to the plan.

Zone I is determined by the project in accordance with the land use plan in the area of forest areas and the possibility of building new buildings is not given, but only the renovation of old houses in the existing dimensions. An old house for which renovation is planned belongs to this zone. The approximate area of zone I is 12 364m².

Zone II is defined by the project in accordance with the purpose of the areas in agricultural areas for two agricultural facilities. Those are facilities for the preparation and production of cheese, as well as for the preparation and production of gin. In accordance with the conditions, it is allowed to form 2 urban plots with a minimum area of 1500m^2 , on which it is possible to build an object with a maximum gross building area of $2x350\text{m}^2$, i.e. 700m^2 and floors GF+1 or GF+Attic. The frame area of zone II is 5317m^2 .

Zone III is defined by the project in accordance with the purpose of the area in the area of other natural areas for housing, because it is located within the boundaries of the settlement, that is, according to the guidelines, it is possible to accept the immediate surroundings up to 100m from the boundary of the settlement and allow the use of housing. The condition for forming a minimum urban plot is an area of 500m², the maximum gross building area GBA is 200m², and the permitted number of floors is GF+1 or GF+Pk. The approximate area of zone III is 8,900m² and the project foresees 11 villas with a total gross building area of 2,200m².



The approximate area of zone IV is 32,219m², and the project foresees 1 eco-village on it, with a total gross area of all buildings of 1,500m².





In accordance with these guidelines, region II, with a total area of 64,075m², is divided into 2 zones with uses according to the plan.


Zone IV is defined by the project in accordance with the purpose of the surfaces in the area of other natural surfaces at a distance of more than 100m from the border of the settlement and it is allowed to build eco-villages. Eco village represents a set of facilities in a village/rural environment, intended for tourist exploitation, which function in a sustainable manner. With their offer, they provide visitors with an extraordinary experience, a break from the usual activities characteristic of life in the city and a pleasant atmosphere in the natural environment. The condition to form an eco-village is a minimum area of 3ha on which it is possible to build facilities with a total gross building area of a maximum of 1,500m². The eco-village should have a central square with facilities for gathering, a parking area, 5 to 10 houses (2-4 users per house), floors GF+Attic or SB+GF.



- Cadastral plot no. 4728 KO Meterizi, is located in the area of other natural surfaces
- Cadastral plot no. 4729 KO Meterizi, is located partly in the area of other natural surfaces and partly within the boundaries of settlements and other built structures.

In accordance with these guidelines, region III, with a total area of 84,082m², is divided into 2 zones with uses according to the plan.


Zone III is defined by the project in accordance with the purpose of the surfaces in the area of other natural areas for housing, because it is located within the boundaries of the settlement. According to the guidelines, it is possible to accept the immediate surroundings up to 100m from the boundary of the settlement and allow the use of housing. The condition to form a minimum urban plot is an area of 500m², the maximum gross building area is 200m², and the permitted number of floors is GF+Attic or SB+GF. The approximate area of zone III is 13,209m² and the project foresees 14 villas with a total gross area of 2,800m².

Zone IV is defined by the project in accordance with the purpose of the surface in the area of other natural surfaces at a distance of more than 100m from the border of the settlement and it is allowed to build eco villages. Eco village represents a set of facilities in a village/rural environment, intended for tourist exploitation, which function in a sustainable manner. The condition to form an eco-village is a minimum area of 3ha on which it is possible to build facilities with a total gross building area of a maximum of 1,500m². The eco-village should have a central square with facilities for gathering, a parking area, 5 to 10 houses (2-4 users per house), floors GF+Attic or SB+GF.














The conclusion
